OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL

Resolution No. 84001 C.M.S.

A RESOLUTION (1) AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT EXTENSION BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATES ("RDA") IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$26,600) FOR OUTCOME AND PROCESS EVALUATION SERVICES OF THE MEASURE Y VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAMMING FROM JULY 1, 2012 TO OCTOBER 31, 2012; AND (2) WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL/QUALIFICATIONS PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH RDA

WHEREAS, City of Oakland voters passed Measure Y – the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 – to provide tax revenue each year for ten years to support violence prevention and public safety programs and services in Oakland's neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Violence Prevention and Pubic Safety Act of 2004 mandates an independent evaluation of Measure Y funded programs to ascertain the effectiveness of the programs; and

WHEREAS, the Council previously approved a contract with RDA for outcome and process evaluation services of the Measure Y programming by Resolution No. 81495 C.M.S.; and

WHEREAS, staff is preparing a request for proposals and qualifications for a new Measure Y evaluation contract; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that it is in the best interest of the City to maintain continuity in the current evaluation of Measure Y services and programs while the Request for Proposal process for a new Measure Y evaluation is completed; and

WHEREAS, Resources Development Associates, as the current Measure Y evaluator, has the expertise and experience to continue the evaluation for four additional months; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code section 2.04.051.B permits the Council to waive the request for proposal/qualifications ("RFP/Q") process upon a finding that it is in the best interest of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that it is in the best interest of the City to waive the RFP/Q process so that the Measure Y Violence Prevention programs can continue to be evaluated as required by the Measure Y – Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to execute a contract extension with RDA in an amount not to exceed twenty-six thousand six hundred dollars (\$26,600) for continued outcome and process evaluation services of the Measure Y Violence Prevention programming from July 1, 2012 to October 31, 2012; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council finds that pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code section 2.04.051.B for the reasons stated above and in the City Administrator's report accompanying this resolution, that it is in the best interest of the City to waive the RFP/Q process for the services to be purchased under the proposed contract extension and so waives the requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, and execute and submit all documentation including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary in accordance with the basic purpose of the contract extension, at no additional contract costs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposed contract extension shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


