## KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS



Staff determined that since the Department currently receives direct benefits in the form of training and equipment as part of its ongoing collaboration with the San Jose Police Department's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force program, coupled with the agency's inability to devote a minimum of one, full-time equipment employee to the proposed venture, there is no basis for the Department to participate.
