**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR PUBLIC STREET RENAMING**

WHEREAS, the City's street renaming policy was established in an Engineering Services Directive dated December 15, 1995 and officially adopted by motion of the City Council on January 16, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to establish new criteria for the renaming of public streets; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council may, by its own motion, consider the renaming of a public street as a tribute to an individual, or as a result of a significant event or activity, if the following criteria is met:

1. The individual has positively impacted the lives of a nation or the world;
2. The name change is related to an economic development or redevelopment activity;
3. The renaming commemorates a significant historical event.
