RESOLUTION NO. 83479 - C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF ALAMEDA FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BAY TRAIL PROJECT AT THE HIGH STREET BRIDGE

WHEREAS, City Council has directed staff to implement the Bay Trail project along the Oakland waterfront, including those sections at the bridges that cross to Alameda per Council Resolution 82096 C.M.S. on June 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Bay Trail at High Street will be integral to and require modification of Alameda County's High Street Bridge facility; and

WHEREAS, a Cooperative Agreement is required to formalize the partnership between the City of Oakland (City) and the County of Alameda (County) in order to define division of responsibilities for funding, design, construction, operation, maintenance, and public liability; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 504(l) authorizes the City Administrator to enter into intergovernmental agreements such as this Cooperative Agreement with Council approval, and intergovernmental agreements are not subject to Oakland's purchasing requirements; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the County to implement the Bay Trail Project at the High Street Bridge; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
