

RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE McClymonds High School Boys Varsity Basketball Team for their Outstanding Season and Reaching the Division I State Championship Finals

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2007, the McClymonds High School Boys Varsity Basketball Team, *The Warriors*, won the CIF Section Championships, advancing to the State Finals, making their first appearance at the state championships since 1978; and

WHEREAS, under the leadership of Head Coach Dwight Nathaniel, a 1974 McClymonds graduate, and Assistant Coach Brandon Brooks, McClymonds' starting point guard in the 1978 Northern California Tournament of Champions title game (which McClymonds won), on March 10, 2007, *The Warriors* overpowered defending state champ, the De La Salle Spartans, 46-36 in the CIF Northern California Division I boys' semifinals; and

WHEREAS, *The Warriors* advanced to the Northern California Championship at the Stockton Arena on March 17, 2007, continuing an impressive playoff run with a thrilling 69-68 overtime win against Oak Grove for the NorCal Regional Championship title; and

WHEREAS, *The Warriors* then faced the SoCal Regional Champions, the Fairfax Lions, at the Arco Arena in Sacramento on March 24, 2007, losing the game but still ranking # 2 in the State; and

WHEREAS, a member of each team at the state championships is awarded the Pursuing Victory with Honor Award, and this year that award went to Frank Otis, McClymonds' power forward; and

WHEREAS, *The Warriors*, also known as "The Mack Family" for playing with a lot of heart, had a stunning season overall, recognized for their phenomenal team pressure defense, with an overall record of 28 wins and 4 losses, and a league record of 9 wins and 1 loss, winning the Oakland Athletic League Championship, the Section Championship, and the NorCal Regional Championship; and

WHEREAS, after the championships, the Reverend Jesse Jackson congratulated the McClymonds High School boys basketball team during a stop in West Oakland, commending the team for practicing six days a week, three hours a day, while pursuing academic excellence as well; and

WHEREAS, the McClymonds team has five graduating seniors – Antwon Graham (#14), Vincent McGhee (#20), Michael Brown (#32), Dannon Lemon (#34), and Christopher Randel (#42) – all of whom are heading to college, proving them as the champions they have been proclaimed; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council recognizes and praises the McClymonds High School Boys Varsity Basketball Team, *The Warriors*, and their coaches for their outstanding season, for their academic success, and for their status as the 2007 NorCal Regional Champions.
