

NOTICE AND DIGEST

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 5.80 AND 5.81 OF THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO: (1) AUTHORIZE THE RETAIL SALE, CULTIVATION, DISTRIBUTION, TESTING, AND MANUFACTURING OF ADULT-USE (RECREATIONAL) CANNABIS; (2) CLARIFY ALLOWED LOCATIONS FOR DELIVERY ONLY CANNABIS DISPENSARIES; (3) EXPAND THE TYPES OF DOCUMENTATION AN EQUITY PROGRAM APPLICANT CAN USE TO SHOW INCOME AND LOCAL RESIDENCY; AND (4) CLARIFY WHAT LOCAL AUTHORIZATION MEANS FOR THE PURPOSES OF A BUSINESS OBTAINING A TEMPORARY STATE LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITY.

This ordinance amends Chapters 5.80 and 5.81 of the Oakland Municipal Code to authorize the retail sale, cultivation, distribution, testing, and manufacturing of adult-use (recreational) cannabis. It aligns the permitting and operating requirements for adult use cannabis with the existing medical cannabis requirements as provided under the Oakland Municipal Code.

It also clarifies that delivery only dispensaries shall not be open to the public and must also be located in a Commercial or Industrial Zone, excluding the CN Neighborhood Center Commercial Zones and the D-BV Broadway Valdez District Commercial Zones, or their equivalent as may be amended, of the City. It further clarifies that delivery only dispensaries shall not occupy more than three thousand (3,000) square feet of ground floor storefront space in a building facing a commercially zoned principal street. The ordinance also expands the forms of documentation for which a person or entity applying for a cannabis "equity" permit pursuant to Chapter 5.80 or 5.81 may use to show income and local residency information. It also clarifies that persons or entities with permits issued pursuant to Chapters 5.80 and 5.81 shall be deemed as authorized to conduct commercial cannabis activity for the purposes of obtaining a state temporary license pursuant to California Business and Professions Code Section 26050.1.
