A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A \$25,000 GRANT RECEIVED FROM TEE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY NATIONAL EMERGENCY TRAINING CENTER (NETC) TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (OES) FOR TEE PURPOSE OF PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTING THE FIRE SAFE CITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the people of Oakland are at risk of experiencing death, injury or property loss from residential fires; and

WHEREAS, those deaths, injuries and property losses from residential fires can be minimized and /or prevented through a comprehensive fire safety program that includes **the** distribution of smoke detectors, batteries to low and fixed-income residents; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department Office of Emergency Services has developed a partnership of private and public agencies to create a comprehensive fire safety program; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department Office of Emergency Services and firefighters have the resources and means necessary to distribute smoke detectors **and** batteries to low and fixed-income residents; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department is fully committed to reducing the threat of fire to its residents;

WHEREAS, the NETC awarded a \$25,000 planning grant to the Oakland Fire Department to develop a *Fire Safe City* program for outreach into the community, especially to the low and fixed-income residents; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that the *Fire* Safe *City* partnership of private and public agencies create a comprehensive fire safety program that reduces the risk of death and injury or property loss from residential fires.

RESOLVED, that the Oakland Fire Department, Office of Emergency Services and firefighter s have the resources and means necessary to distribute smoke detectors, batteries and fire prevention information to low and fixed-income residents to reduce the threat of fires.

RESOLVED, that the NETC awarded a \$25,000 grant to Oakland Fire Department for the Fire Safe City program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oakland City Council, by adoption of this resolution, hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with additional monies to Oakland Fire Department to plan and implement the Fire Safe City program.
