

RESOLUTION No. 76131 C.M.S.



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$5,196,455 DOLLARS FROM THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION'S TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES FUNDS, AND TO APPROPRIATE UP TO \$297,000 FROM CITY FUNDS AS MATCHING DOLLARS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE EASTLAKE, FRUITVALE, AND WEST OAKLAND AREAS

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Transportation for Livable Communities has awarded \$5,196,455 dollars for capital improvement projects in the EastLake, Fruitvale, and West Oakland areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland will match the EastLake capital improvement project with \$217,000 from City of Oakland funds; and

WHEREAS, the Community and Economic Development Agency and the Public Works Agency are the sponsoring agencies and has been working in partnership with local community groups to develop the capital improvement project designs; and

WHEREAS, the Community and Economic Development Agency recommends that the Public Works Agency administer the design and construction of these projects and that these funds be placed in an accessible account for use by the Public Works Agency; and

WHEREAS, the 11.5% match has been allocated to each of the capital improvement projects as **part** of the application; anti now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That ~~the~~ City Council hereby ~~authorizes the~~ City Manager or his designee to accept \$5,196,455 dollars from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Transportation for Livable Communities Funds and appropriates up to \$297,000 from \$55,000 from FY 1999-2001 Community Development Block Grant Funds and \$212,000 from City Council District II Neighborhood Traffic and Safety Funds ~~for the EastLake~~ project; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into contracts and to take whatever other action he deems is necessary
