My passion is building supportive community, and my experience spans decades. Examples: In 1997 I envisioned and organized a neighborhood sign language class to support a family in our community who had learned that their daughter is deaf. Wrote a successful grant proposal to fund a teacher for the class. We offered the class for two years and had good participation. For more than ten years, beginning in 2007, I volunteered for nonprofit African Cradle in a variety of capacities, including helping to organize and implement an annual Ethiopian Heritage Camp for families touched by adoption. My daughter, now a young adult, has spoken at length about how important it was to her to have the camp community. From 2015 to 2019, I was an active member of Neighbors for Racial Justice, an Oakland Dimond based neighborhood focused on creating racial equity and justice in our neighborhoods and city. I worked in a variety of capacities, including maintaining the Vigil for Black Lives every Saturday. I am still actively involved in maintaining the vigil and enjoy strong ties with the current members. I took the initiative to organize our block on Arden Place in Oakland two years ago. We have had several block parties since then and we enjoy excellent participation. Beginning in early 2020, I joined the Steering Committee of the Oakland 22x Neighborhood Council. During that time I have served as either Chair or Co-Chair. I am most proud of my efforts to organize a Cooperative Neighborhood Gathering (CoNee G) in August of this year. This is an idea I hope to expand through the Neighborhood Council program in Oakland. I served as an Advisory Board Member for the Reimagining Public Safety Task Force. I hope to help strengthen the Neighborhood Council and Block Organizing programs in Oakland if selected to serve on the Board.

# RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF JENNIFER ZILLIAC AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 72727 C.M.S., adopted June 11, 1996 and amended by Resolution No. 73916 C.M.S., adopted November 4, 1997, which changed the body's status from a Task Force to a Board, establishes that the Community Policing Advisory Board shall oversee, monitor and report at least twice yearly and provide recommendations on community policing to the Mayor, City Council, City Manager, and director of Police Services; and

WHEREAS, the Community Policing Advisory Board consists of fifteen (15) members, all Oakland residents, serving three-year terms, three appointed by the Mayor, one by each Councilmember, one by the Oakland Housing Authority, one by the Oakland Unified School District Board, and two by the Home Alert Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed Jennifer Zilliac to serve a three-year term, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of:

**Jennifer Zilliac** to the Community Policing Advisory Board to serve a three-year term, as the District 4 Representative, that began March 25, 2021 and ends March 24, 2024, filling the seat previously held by Ravinder Singh, and be it
