

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF CARMEN DOMER v. CITY OF OAKLAND, ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. RG1155133 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,000.00 (PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY – TRIP AND FALL)

WHEREAS: Plaintiff Carmen Domer tripped on an uneven section of the sidewalk in front of 6200 Antioch Street, causing her to fall and break her left foot;

WHEREAS: Plaintiff Carmen Domer has filed the above-referenced lawsuit seeking damages arising from this incident;

WHEREAS: The City has determined to compromise and settle Plaintiff's claim against it for the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars and no Cents (\$8,000.00);

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Carmen Domer v. City of Oakland, et al, Alameda County Superior Court No. RG1155133, City Attorney's File No. 27786, for a sum not to exceed Eight Thousand Dollars and no Cents (\$8,000.00), payable by the City of Oakland.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it


