**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$255,000) FROM THE CALIFORNIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, UNDER THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 (FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S "STIMULUS PACKAGE") FOR THE ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING TASK FORCE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$255,000 will be awarded by the California Emergency Management Agency, under the American Recovery and Revitalization Act (ARRA) of 2009, for the Anti-Human Trafficking Task Force Program; and

**WHEREAS**, due the urgent economic conditions, the federal government is releasing information on an ongoing basis concerning application deadlines and the criteria for funding and the types of programs, projects that will qualify for the funding and the Mayor, City Administrator and the City Council wish to be in the best posture (1) to be apprised of and updated regarding developments regarding the Stimulus Package and the City's options and (2) to prepare and complete and revise as necessary timely grant applications and (3) to obtain the maximum amount of grant funds for which the City of Oakland may be eligible; and

**WHEREAS**, the City learned that funds are available from the California Emergency Management Agency, under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) OF 2009 (Federal "Stimulus Package"), and wishes to apply for said funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has learned that the deadline for the application is November 30, 2009, now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the Oakland City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator or his designee, on behalf of the City of Oakland to apply for grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$255,000 from the California Emergency Management Agency, under the ARRA of 2009 (federal government's "Stimulus Package") for the Anti-Human Trafficking Task Force Program; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, as agent of the City, to conduct all negotiations and related actions to sign all applications and agreements that may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grant.


