RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REJECTION OF ALL BIDS ON THE LAUREL STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENT ON MACARTHUR BLVD. (BETWEEN 35TH AVE. AND HIGH ST.) (PROJECT NO. C194710), AND FORMALLY RE-BID WITH RETURN TO COUNCIL FOR AWARD

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2003, five bids were received and opened by the City Clerk for the Laurel Streetscape Improvement on MacArthur Blvd. (Between 35th Ave. and High St.), a community-requested project; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bidder is J.W. Riley & Son, Inc., and his bid amount is \$1,698,000, which exceeds the engineer's estimate plus contingencies by over 35%; and

WHEREAS, Pagni Construction, Inc.'s bid was determined to be non-responsive due to clerical error—total bid amount was not provided; and

WHEREAS, all remaining bids exceed the engineer's estimate plus contingencies by over 35%; and

WHEREAS, the construction budget does not have sufficient funds to cover the apparent low bid, and all bids should be rejected and re-bid; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager is authorized to reject all bids and re-bid the project, and return to Council for award; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of Public Works for this project are hereby approved.
