AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 12443 C.M.S. (MASTER FEE SCHEDULE), AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH FEES ASSESSED BY THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER, NUISANCE ENFORCEMENT UNIT, AND THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY FOR PUBLIC NUISANCE AND NUISANCE EVICTION CASES

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland periodically updates its Master Fee Schedule to account for general cost of living increases and program changes or other costs; and

WHEREAS, the fee modifications and additions proposed herein have been justified by the respective agencies and are identified in a letter dated January 27, 2004 from the City Manager to the Public Safety Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the herein-referenced modifications and additions are necessary to reimburse the City for the costs of performing the various municipal and regulatory functions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Oakland does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Master Fee Schedule as set forth in Ordinance Number 12443 C.M.S., as amended, is hereby amended to establish fees assessed by the Office of the City Manager (Nuisance Enforcement Unit) and the Office of the City Attorney as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.


