


The information provided below was requested by members of the Public Safety Committee on Tuesday, November 14, 2006, after receiving a report and proposed resolution requesting authorization for the City Administrator to accept grant funds in the amount of \$102,701.76 from the University of California, Berkeley, Traffic Safety Center, Office of Traffic Safety, for the 2006 Sobriety Checkpoint Program.

During the calendar year 2005, Oakland Police arrested 409 persons for DUI violations. Of the 409 arrested, 24 were arrested during DUI checkpoint operations. There were a total of eight checkpoint operations conducted in 2005.
