RESOLUTION No. _____ C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000 FOR THE LOWELL STREET CORRIDOR COMMUNITY STREETScape PLAN AND AUTHORIZING A LOCAL MATCH OF \$20,000 FROM CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 DISCRETIONARY FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland desires to improve the sub-standard infrastructure and street conditions in the Lowell Street Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is submitting an application to the California Transportation Agency ("Caltrans") Transportation Planning Environmental Justice Planning Grant Program for \$200,000 to develop a streetscape plan for the provision of upgraded infrastructure to Lowell Street; and

WHEREAS, the Caltrans Transportation Planning Environmental Justice Planning Grant Program requires a local match of \$20,000 which will be appropriated from Capital Reserves Fund (5510) City Council District 1 Discretionary Pay-Go Funds (Project B273010); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to apply, accept, and appropriate grant funds from the Caltrans Transportation Planning Environmental Justice Program; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland has independently reviewed and considered this environmental determination, and the City finds and determines that this action complies with CEQA because this action on the part of the City is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15262 (feasibility and planning studies), Section 15306 (information collection) and Section 15061(b)(3) (general rule) of the CEQA guidelines; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That, if awarded, the grant funds will be appropriated to Fund 2140 (California Department of Transportation Grant Fund) under a new project number to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That funding for the required \$20,000 matching funds will be appropriated from Capital Reserves Fund (5510) City Council District 1

Discretionary Pay-Go Funds (Project B273010) to a new project number to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to negotiate grant terms, appropriate revenue, make expenditures and take all other actions necessary in accordance with this Resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all documents shall be reviewed and approved by City Attorney prior to execution, and copies will be placed on file with the City Clerk.
