RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONVERSION OF E.16TH AND E.17TH STREETS FROM 62ND TO 64TH AVENUES TO ONE-WAY STREETS

WHEREAS, petitions signed by said block residents indicate that more than 90% of the addresses on both blocks are in favor of the one-way conversion, and

WHEREAS, traffic engineering analysis and field reconnaissance confirm that converting said blocks to one-way can alleviate congestion during the schools' commute periods, and

WHEREAS, at three community meetings sponsored by Oakland Community Organizations with Saint Bernard Church and School, Whittier School, local residents, and City officials and staff, community representatives showed preponderant support in favor of the one-way conversion; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the conversion of East 16th and East 17th streets between 62nd and 64th avenues from two-way to one-way operation is hereby approved.
