ORDINANCE NO. 12740 C.M.S.

ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 12728, WHICH AMENDED TITLE 5 OF THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD CHAPTER 5.82, TO REQUIRE FRANCHISES IN WHICH THE CITY HAS AN PROPRIETARY INTEREST TO ENTER INTO A CARD CHECK AGREEMENT, A PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINING EMPLOYEE PREFERENCE ON REPRESENTATION BY A LABOR ORGANIZATION THAT REQUESTS SUCH AN AGREEMENT

The Council of the City of Oakland does ordain as follows:

- 1) Ordinance No. 12728, entitled Proprietary Interest Franchise labor Requirements – Card Check, Procedure for Determining Employee preference on Representation by Labor Organization, is hereby repealed.
- 2) Title 5, Chapter 5.82, of the Oakland Municipal Code, shall be removed.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately on final adoption if it receives six or more affirmative votes; otherwise it shall become effective upon the seventh day after final adoption.
