WHEREAS, Elections Code Sections 10400 through 10403.5 allow the Oakland Municip Nominating Election to be held on Tuesday, March 2, 2004 and to be consolidated with the Stat Primary Election to be held on the same day; and,		
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oakland does hereby request that the Board of Supervisors of Alameda County order the consolidation of the Municipal Nominating Election will Statewide Primary Election; and now therefore, be it
