WHEREAS, the AYSC sponsors activities and events where its members are taught social, leadership and project management skills; and

WHEREAS, the AYSC regularly participates in community events, including the Oakland Chinatown Street Festival, Wa Sung Easter Pancake Breakfast, Shoreline Costal Cleanup, OPD Christmas Gift Program, Lincoln Square Park Cleanup, and Asian Pacific Islander events; and

WHEREAS, the AYSC also hosts the annual Mildred L. Chinn Memorial Picnic where present and past AYSC members, their family and friends come together for a day of celebration; and

WHEREAS, the AYSC has gained recognition through participation in national and statewide conferences, as evidenced by the several Asian Youth organizations that have modeled themselves after the Oakland AYSC; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland AYSC has been honored with City, County, State and Federal Proclamations; now therefore be it
