RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH URS CORPORATION FOR AS-NEEDED TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERING SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED TWO-HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000)

WHEREAS, professional services are needed to assist the Public Works Agency, Transportation Services Division with data collection, engineering, planning and design for various transportation projects in the following areas: Traffic Signals and Intelligent Transportation Systems; Traffic Calming; Pedestrian Access and Safety; Bicycle Access and Safety; Traffic Safety Systems; Roadway Improvements; On-street and Off-street Parking; Environmental Impact Studies; Development Review and Transit Priority and Bus Rapid Transit; and

WHEREAS, as-needed services agreements allow the City to respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Agency, Transportation Services Division anticipates that several currently funded transportation projects will utilize the as-needed services agreements; and

WHEREAS, mid-year projects will arise throughout the three-year period and will likely require transportation engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the transportation engineering services will be funded through the various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the services; and

WHEREAS, through the City's Request for Qualifications process, URS Corporation was rated as one of the top-ranked firms to provide the services required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the agreement authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the agreement shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a professional service agreement with URS Corporation for as-needed transportation engineering services; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the total amount of the agreement shall be for a not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the term of the agreement shall be for three (3) years and is anticipated to cover the period from August 2005 to August 2008; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreement shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk.
