**COMMENDING HARRY SCHRAUTH

**WHEREAS**, Harry Schrauth, an Oakland native, began his career with the City of Oakland in June of 1962 as a part-time Recreation Attendant with the Recreation Department and for the next five years worked as a Recreation Leader and two years as Director of Kamp Kidd, and;

**WHEREAS**, Harry Schrauth, upon graduation from San Francisco State College with a B.A. in 1966 and the University of Illinois with a M.S. in 1967, began his full-time career as a Recreation Center Director with the Recreation Department and in 1972 was promoted to Recreation Supervisor, and;

**WHEREAS**, Harry Schrauth, in 1977, after receiving a M.P.A. degree from Golden Gate University, completed an internship in the City Manager's Office and later spent nine months with the Office of Budget and Management Services, before being appointed Assistant to the Director of Public Works, and;

**WHEREAS**, Harry Schrauth, from 1997 through 2001, held various positions in the Public Works Agency, including Assistant Director, and at different times was responsible for the management of Contract Compliance and Administration, Fiscal Services, Parking Enforcement, Real Estate, Electrical Services, Environmental Services, Municipal Buildings and the Equipment Department, and;

**WHEREAS**, Harry Schrauth, after 42 years and the equivalent of 39½ years of service to the community in which he lives, Harry wants to end his career with the City of Oakland on July 9, 2004 and get the first stamp on his passport as he travels with his wife Carol who has planned postponed trips to distant places, and;

**WHEREAS**, Harry Schrauth has earned the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates and will truly be missed by all of them, now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**: That the City Council hereby express appreciation and commend Harry Schrauth on behalf of the citizens of Oakland for his many contributions to the City, and be it
