



RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 86496 C.M.S. CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S REAPPOINTMENT OF RACHEL DHARMAPALAN, ADDISON DUCHIN, ELENA LARSEN, RYAN HUNT, GLORIA GUZMAN, AND BETHANIA TADESSE AS MEMBERS OF THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION IN ORDER TO CORRECT THE APPOINTMENTS

WHEREAS, the Youth Advisory Commission was created by Ordinance No.10545 C.M.S., adopted February 5, 1985, amended by Ordinance No. 11461, passed June 23, 1992, and amended by Ordinance No. 11869, passed March 12, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Youth Advisory Commission is comprised of Twenty-Five youth from ages 13 to 21, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, one to represent each Council District and the remaining eighteen to serve as at-large members, with all appointments being for a period of two years, with a limit of two consecutive terms; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Youth Advisory Commission is to identify the needs of youth of the community from the ages of 13 to 21, thereby creating citizen awareness of such needs and serving as the policy recommending body for civic/education-related matters within the jurisdiction of the City of Oakland in which youth have an interest, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 86496 C.M.S. the City Council confirmed the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf's reappointment of Rachel Dharmapalan, Addison Duchin, Elena Larsen, Ryan Hunt, Gloria Guzman and Bethania Tadesse to the Oakland Youth Advisory Commission; and

WHEREAS, some of the appointments confirmed in Resolution No. 86496 did not accurately reflect the Council District represented by the appointee; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby amends Resolution No. 86496 C.M.S. and pursuant to City Charter section 601, confirms the following appointments to the Youth Advisory Commission:

Rachel Dharmapalan, Mayoral reappointment to serve a two-year term as a District 2 appointee that began July 1, 2016 and will end June 30, 2018, retaining the seat she previously held.
