SUMMARY

On February 16th, Council approved measures to balance the General Purpose Fund budget for FY 2009-10. One of those balancing items was a \$1 million payment from the Redevelopment Agency, to support existing job training and housing appropriations within the General Purpose Fund, thus freeing up \$1 million for budget balancing.

On April 1st, a report was presented to Council that included an allocation of General Purpose Fund job training and housing projects to be supported by the \$1 million Redevelopment Agency payment. Council requested that the allocation be amended; this report presents that amended allocation.

FISCAL IMPACT

The contributions will be made from a Redevelopment Agency planning fund (#9103), non-project cash balances, and will be used to support various General Purpose Fund housing and job training projects that had already been revenue-supported for FY 2009-10, thus freeing up an additional \$1 million in revenue. The \$1 million will be accepted as revenue into the General Purpose Fund (1010), Citywide Activities Org (90591), non-project. This revenue was originally paid to the City under the terms of the City Center Walk Housing Development Design and Disposition Agreement, which specified it could only be spent for the purposes of job training and/or housing. The revenue therefore must be used for those purposes.

RECOMMENDATION(S) AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends approval of two resolutions: 1) to contribute \$1 million from the Agency to the City under the Cooperation Agreement to fund various job training and housing programs; and 2) to accept and appropriate \$1 million from the Agency to fund various job training and housing programs.

This \$1 million transfer was approved by the City Council on February 16, 2010 as part of the City's FY 2009-10 General Purpose Fund balancing measures (Resolution No. 82582 C.M.S.). If the attached resolutions are not approved, an additional \$1 million in savings for the General Purpose Fund would have to be found.

WHEREAS, since at least 1993, financial contributions have been made by private developers to the Redevelopment Agency under the City Center Disposition and Development Agreement to be used for the purposes of funding job training and housing activities; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency and the City entered into a Cooperation Agreement on July 1, 2004, which governs the provision of assistance and the payment of funds between the two agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City conducts or supports job training and housing activities that are consistent with the purposes under which the original contributions were made to the Agency under the City Center Disposition and Development Agreement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Redevelopment Agency hereby contributes \$1,000,000 to the City under the Cooperation Agreement to fund job training and housing programs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the \$1,000,000 contribution will be contributed from the Agency's West Oakland Planning/Coliseum Community Investment Fund (#9103), non-project cash balances; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contribution of said funds shall serve as partial payment for the loan made by the City to the Agency for redevelopment of the Oak Center Redevelopment Project Area; and be it further

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agency Administrator may take whatever action is necessary with respect to said contribution consistent with this Resolution and its basic purposes.
