**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE TEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FOUR CENTS (\$10,124.74) IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT IN OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT COSTS FOR FOUR (4) POLICE OFFICER CANINE TEAMS ASSIGNED TO THE SECURE AUTOMOBILE INSPECTION LANES II LARKSPUR FERRY PROJECT FROM AUGUST 29, 2005 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 9, 2005**

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Security Administration (hereinafter "TSA") conducted an experimental project titled Secure Automobile Inspection Lanes (SAIL ) II (hereinafter "SAIL II") to test technologies to develop and implement an efficient passenger screening system for the high thoroughfare commuter ferry sector of the maritime industry; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Police Department (hereinafter "OPD") agreed to provide four (4) police officer canine teams to participate in SAIL II Project from August 29, 2005 through September 9, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, the TSA agrees to reimburse the City \$10,124.74 in overtime costs incurred by the officer canine teams assigned to the SAIL II Project for the period August 29, 2005 through September 9, 2005; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or her designee, to accept reimbursement funds in an amount of \$10,124.74 from the TSA for deposit into the Police Department General Fund 1010, Airport Security Organization Code 105650, to the Program (PS33), Account 45718, for the overtime reimbursement costs of four (4) police officer canine teams assigned to the SAIL II Project from August 29, 2005 through September 9, 2005; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or her designee, to execute any further documents necessary to implement this resolution; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is authorized to modify, extend, or amend said agreement provided that no additional funds shall be allocated without prior City Council approval.


