RESOLUTION NO. 80761 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO EXECUTE A ONE-YEAR GRANT AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 BETWEEN THE CITY AND THROUGH THE LOOKING GLASS TO PROVIDE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES TO THE OAKLAND HEAD START PROGRAM, AND CONTINGENT UPON RECEIPT OF HEAD START GRANT FUNDING AND GRANTEE'S SATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A ONE-YEAR EXTENSION FOR AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 CULMINATING IN A TWO-YEAR TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has received authorization from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to provide Head Start services for children in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program Performance Standards promulgated by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for all Head Start Programs require that mental health services be made available to children and families enrolled in the Head Start Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Department of Human Services desires to enter into a Grant Agreement with Through the Looking Glass to provide mental health services for Program Year 2007-2008; and

WHEREAS, the provider has met all of the requirements for mental health providers and was among the top candidates who applied for the contract; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Head Start intends to submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, for funding Head Start grant agreements for program Year 2008-09; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$50,000 are available to pay for these services in the Department of Health and Human Services Fund (2128), Head Start Organization (78231), Head Start Project (G3051xx); and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement with Through the Looking Glass may be subject to the City of Oakland's three percent contract compliance fee which would amount to \$1,500 and not imposing or disregarding the Contract Compliance Assessment fee would increase the existing negative balance in the Contract Compliance Assessment Fund (1790); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the performance of this service is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this grant agreement shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee as an agent for the City to execute a Grant Agreement Contract between the City and Through the Looking Glass, to provide mental health services to the City of Oakland Head Start Program in an amount not to exceed \$50,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments, modifications, or extensions of this Grant Agreement, including a one-year extension of the grant agreement contingent upon receipt of Head Start grant funding and the satisfactory performance of grantee, for an additional amount not to exceed \$50,000, and provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
