WHEREAS, on March 21, 2009 Plaintiff Douglas Laughlin sustained personal and civil rights injuries while filming a newsworthy event; and

WHERERAS, the City of Oakland has determined that settlement in this amount, without an admission of liability, is in the best interest of the City and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of <u>Douglas Laughlin v. City of Oakland, et. al.</u>, United States District Court, Northern District of California Case No. CV 10-2422 WHA, for the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (175,000.00); and be it
