INTRODUCED BY MAYOR LIBBY SCHAAF

**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF ZACHARY KNOX AS A MEMBER OF THE CANNABIS REGULATORY COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members, of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Cannabis Regulation and Revenue Act (Ordinance 12694 C.M.S.), also known as Measure Z, adopted by the voters of Oakland, November 2, 2004 in the General Municipal Election, creates the Cannabis Regulatory Commission to oversee the ordinance's implementation and the disbursement of revenue from licensing and taxation of businesses that sell cannabis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Cannabis Regulation and Revenue Act specifies that members of the Cannabis Regulatory Commission are to be appointed one by the Mayor, one by the City Auditor, one by the City Administrator, and one from each Member of the City Council, to serve unlimited two-year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed **Zachary Knox** to serve a two-year term subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of **Zachary Knox**, Mayoral appointment to serve a two-year term as the District 3 Representative that began August 1, 2015 and ending July 31, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Sierra Martinez.
