**An Ordinance Requesting Consolidation Of The City Of Oakland General Municipal Election With The Statewide General Election To Be Held In The City Of Oakland On Tuesday, November 2, 2010**

**WHEREAS**, Oakland City Charter Section 1101 stipulates that a general election be held the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in each even numbered year; and

**WHEREAS**, Charter Section 1100 authorizes the Council to establish the date for the Municipal Nominating Election to conform with the Statewide Primary Election.

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code Sections 10400 through 10403.5 allow the Oakland Municipal Nominating Election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010 and to be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same day; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Oakland does hereby request that the Board of Supervisors of Alameda County order the consolidation of the City Oakland General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election; and now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**: That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary under the law to prepare for and conduct the November 2, 2010 Oakland General Municipal Election and the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate all monies necessary for the City Clerk to prepare for and conduct said election consistent with the Charter of the City Oakland, the Oakland Municipal Code and State Elections Code where applicable and therefore, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Council of the City of Oakland hereby authorizes and directs the City Clerk, at least 88 days prior to the November 2, 2010 Oakland General Municipal Election to forward certified copies of this resolution to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors and the Alameda County Registrar of Voters.
