RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A: 1) TWO-HOUR PARKING ZONE ON SAN PABLO AVENUE (EAST SIDE) BETWEEN 59<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND STANFORD AVENUE; 2) NO PARKING ANY TIME ZONE ON EMBARCADERO EAST (NORTH SIDE) BETWEEN SAN ANTONIO CREEK AND 5<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE; 3) NO PARKING BETWEEN 3:00AM AND 6:00AM ZONE ON CLAREMONT AVENUE (BOTH SIDES) BETWEEN CLIFTON STREET AND HUDSON STREET; AND 4) REMOVAL OF A TWO-HOUR PARKING ZONE ON 41<sup>ST</sup> STREET (SOUTH SIDE) BEWTEEN SHAFTER AVENUE AND WEBSTER STREET

## **SUMMARY**

A resolution has been prepared approving the establishment of a two-hour parking zone on the East side of San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue, the establishment of a no parking any time zone on the North side of Embarcadero East between San Antonio Creek and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, the establishment of a no parking between 3:00am and 6:00am zone on both sides of Claremont Avenue between Clifton Street and Hudson Street, and the removal of a two-hour parking zone on the South side of 41<sup>st</sup> Street between Shafter Avenue and Webster Street. Sections 10.28.190, 10.28.250 and 10.28.260 of the Oakland Municipal Code allow, by resolution, the establishment/removal of two-hour parking, no parking any time, and no parking between certain hours, respectively, based on parking demands and community request.

The proposed parking restriction, additions and removal are consistent with the following Mayor/City Council goals and citywide objectives:

Make Oakland a Safe City and Improve Oakland Neighborhoods by improving traffic, bike, and pedestrian safety and by enhancing neighborhood commerce.

#### FISCAL IMPACTS

The cost to implement the proposed installations is approximately \$800. The Traffic Maintenance Division of the Public Works Agency will perform the work. Funds are available in the Public Works Agency's Transportation Services Division budget.

The funding source is the State Gas Tax Fund (2230), under the Neighborhood Traffic Safety Program, Project No. C159610.

### **BACKGROUND**

The proposed two-hour parking zone on San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue, no parking zone on Embarcadero East between San Antonio Creek and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, no parking between 3:00am and 6:00am zone on Claremont Avenue between Clifton Street and Hudson Street, and removal of two-hour parking zone on 41<sup>st</sup> Street between Shafter Avenue and Webster Street were all requested by the public. The required qualified petitions signed by the adjacent businesses and property owners were submitted in support of the request.

## **KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS**

To increase short-term parking supply for their customers, the businesses on San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue submitted a petition to install a two-hour parking zone on the East side of the street. To discourage overnight parking of recreational vehicles and trailers, the businesses on Embarcadero East between San Antonio Creek and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue submitted a petition to install a no parking zone on the North side of the street. To address the same issue of overnight parking of recreational vehicles and trailers, a no parking zone between 3:00am and 6:00am on Claremont Avenue between Clifton Street and Hudson Street was also requested by citizens with the support of their Council office. On the South side of 41<sup>st</sup> Street between Shafter Avenue and Webster Street, residents petitioned to remove an existing two-hour zone to meet their long-term parking needs.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

## **Economic**

The proposed two-hour parking on San Pablo Avenue will sustain commercial businesses by increasing parking accessibility for their customers.

#### Environmental

None.

# **Social Equity**

The proposed parking prohibition on Embarcadero East and Claremont Avenue will benefit the immediate neighborhoods by eliminating overnight parking of recreational vehicles and trailers, thereby eliminating a potential perceived source of blight. The proposed removal of two-hour parking on 41<sup>st</sup> Street will enable residents to park long term as needed, thereby improving the livability of their neighborhood.

# **DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS**

Time-limited parking on San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue will provide more opportunities for disabled and senior citizens to find available parking closer to their destinations. Vehicles displaying a disabled placard will be exempted from the time-limited parking.

### RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends approval of the resolution to establish a two-hour parking zone on the East side of San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue, a no parking any time zone on the North side of Embarcadero East between San Antonio Creek and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, a no parking between 3:00am and 6:00am zone on both sides of Claremont Avenue between Clifton Street and Hudson Street, and to remove a two-hour parking zone on the South side of 41<sup>st</sup> Street between Shafter Avenue and Webster Street.

WHEREAS, a two-hour parking zone on the east side of San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue has been successfully petitioned by adjacent businesses to discourage all-day parking; and

WHEREAS, a no parking any time zone on the north side of Embarcadero East between San Antonio Creek and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue has been successfully petitioned by adjacent businesses to discourage overnight parking of recreational vehicles and trailers; and,

WHEREAS, a no parking between 3:00am and 6:00am zone on both sides of Claremont Avenue between Clifton Street and Hudson Street has been requested by citizens to discourage overnight parking of recreational vehicles and trailers; and,

WHEREAS, the removal of a two-hour parking zone on the south side of 41<sup>st</sup> Street between Shafter Avenue and Webster Street has been successfully petitioned by adjacent property owners to allow long-term parking by residents; now, therefore, be it,

**RESOLVED:** That the installation of a two-hour parking zone, installation of a no parking any time zone, installation of a no parking between 3:00am and 6:00am zone and removal of a two-hour parking zone as described below are hereby approved:

# TWO-HOUR AND NO PARKING ZONES

- 1. SAN PABLO AVENUE Install a two-hour parking zone on the east side of San Pablo Avenue between 59<sup>th</sup> Street and Stanford Avenue.
- 2. EAST EMBARCADERO Install a no parking any time zone on the north side of Embarcadero East between San Antonio Creek and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
