Staff Recommends That The City Council Receive An Annual Informational Report From The Parks And Recreation Advisory Commission.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This informational report from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission (PRAC) contains an update on PRAC activities during the 2020 and 2021 calendar years (**Attachment A**).

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

City Council adopted Ordinance No. 8065 C.M.S. in 1969 which dissolved the Parks and the Recreation Commissions and created the PRAC. The City Council adopted Ordinance No. 11731 C.M.S. in 1994 which amended Ordinance No. 8065 C.M.S. to incorporate uniform requirements the City had established for the selection of members of boards and commissions and their duties, as well as the general responsibilities of boards and commissions.

City Council adopted Ordinance No. 13622 C.M.S in November of 2020 amending and restating Ordinances Nos. 11731 and 8065 C.M.S. to update the duties of the PRAC and to include oversight of the 2020 City of Oakland Parks and Recreation Preservation, Litter Reduction, and Homelessness Support Act (Measure Q). It is the function of the PRAC to study, investigate and research into such matters as the City Administrator or the Council, through the City Administrator, may direct, or as it may deem advisable; to make reports and recommendations thereon and to formulate policy recommendations and plans for the current and future operations and development of the City of Oakland Parks and Recreation System. The PRAC shall submit regular status report to the City Council committee at least once a year.
