

RESOLUTION RENAMING DUNSMUIR HOUSE AND GARDENS TO DUNSMUIR HELLMAN HISTORIC ESTATE

WHEREAS, the Dunsmuir family originally built the Estate, but it was the Hellman family's 50 years of influence and development that made the property what it is today; and

WHEREAS, over the past 30 years, the Hellman family has remained involved in the preservation of the Estate; and

WHEREAS, Dunsmuir Hellman Historic Estate, Inc., the non-profit charged with managing the Estate has requested the renaming; and

WHEREAS, Dunsmuir Hellman Historic Estate, Inc. will provide funding for the production and installation of all signage related to the renaming; and

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Advisory Commission approved the renaming at its September 10, 2008 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the renaming adheres to the criteria of Resolution No. 65024 C.M.S., Designating Official Names for Municipal Facilities, item (b) an individual philanthropist, family, or estate name; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to rename the Dunsmuir House and Gardens, located at 2960 Peralta Oaks Court, the Dunsmuir Hellman Historic Estate; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Office of the City Attorney has approved this resolution as to form and legality, and a copy will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


