A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO FORTY-TWO (42) CULTURAL SERVICES GRANTS TO FORTY-ONE (51) OAKLAND-BASED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUAL ARTISTS PROVIDING ARTS AND CULTURAL SERVICES IN OAKLAND DURING FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$408,745.00

WHEREAS, in 1985, City Council adopted the first arts funding policies and procedures for the City of Oakland, establishing a panel system of evaluating funding proposals and distributing City funds to the arts; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Funding Program is the City's funding mechanism to support Oakland-based nonprofit organizations and artists providing arts and cultural activities to the public; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Cultural Funding Program is to fund Oakland-based art and cultural activities that reflect the diversity of the city for citizens of and visitors to Oakland, focusing on the key areas of General Support, Neighborhood Arts and Arts Education; and

WHEREAS, during March, 2010, three funding review panels convened and forwarded recommendations to award forty-two (42) grants to forty-one (41) organizations and individual artists proposing to provide arts and/or cultural programming in the city of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, Fiscal Year 2010-11 funds for the Cultural Funding Program are budgeted as follows: \$361,217 in Non-Departmental (CCAD – Cultural Programs' – 90523), General Purpose Fund (1010); and a projected total of \$2.4 million in revenues from the Transient Occupancy Tax (fund 2419) surcharge, of which \$47,528 will be set aside for artists' grants (within the Cultural Funding Unit – 88742, and the Cultural Funding Program-Transient Occupancy Tax project – P391850); and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2010, the Life Enrichment Committee of City Council approved specific funding recommendations to nonprofit organizations and individual artists as follows:

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council hereby approves and authorizes a grant to each organization and individual artist listed above in the amount detailed; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That in the event any of the above grants are not encumbered, that those funds shall revert to the Cultural Funding Program for use in other categories of support; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator or her designated representative as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, and related actions which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grants in accordance with their basic purpose; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Office of the City Attorney will approve the grant agreements for form and legality and a copy will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
