**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 00-55 C.M.S. TO
MODIFY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY'S AFFORDABLE
HOUSING SITE ACQUISITION PROGRAM TO EXPAND THE
DEFINITION OF ELIGIBLE PROPERTIES TO INCLUDE THOSE
PROPERTIES OCCUPIED BY RETAIL/COMMERCIAL USES**

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2000, the Redevelopment Agency adopted Resolution No. 00-55 C.M.S. establishing the Affordable Housing Site Acquisition Program and authorizing a \$10 Million allocation from Affordable Housing Bond Proceeds to fund the program; and

WHEREAS, the Program as established was limited only to vacant properties; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency wishes to amend the affordable Housing Site Acquisition Program to expand the definition of the eligible properties to include those properties occupied by retail/commercial uses; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Redevelopment Agency hereby amends Resolution No. 00-55 C.M.S. to modify the Affordable Housing Site Acquisition Program to expand the definition of eligible properties to include those properties occupied by retail/commercial uses.
