

**RESOLUTION TO EXTEND ENFORCEMENT HOURS OF  
PREFERENTIAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM AREAS  
BY TWO HOURS TO 8 P.M.**

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Municipal Code, Sections 10.44.050 and 10.44.120 provide that the City Council may designate residential parking permit areas and provide for the time limitations for parking in the areas, and

**WHEREAS**, certain areas throughout the City are designated for the Residential Permit Parking Program in which parking is restricted during the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. for the parking of vehicles without a permit; and

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance No. 12953 C.M.S., adopted on July 7, 2009, the City Council amended the Oakland Municipal Code, Section 10.36.050 "Parking Meter Indication That Space is Illegally In Use," to extend parking meter hours and enforcement of fines to 8 p.m. for automobiles parked at metered spaces; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parking Division has determined that extension of preferential residential permit parking area hours from 6:00 p.m. to 8 p.m., citywide, will not have an adverse effect on residents and merchants in the areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to make the enforcement of parking restrictions consistent throughout the City and to keep parking available to residents with permits in Residential Permit Parking areas; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That restricted hours of the Residential Permit Parking Program be extended by two hours, so that the period when the appropriate parking permit is required in a residential parking permit area be from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. citywide; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** Based on the determination of the Parking Division, the City Council finds and determines that extension of preferential residential permit parking area hours from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., citywide, will not have an adverse effect on residents and merchants in the areas; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That, unless designated by the City otherwise, general on-street parking on streets within any Preferential Residential Permit Parking Areas shall be restricted to two (2) hours, Monday thru Friday, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., with the exception of vehicles displaying Preferential Residential Permit Parking Area permits; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That signs in the permit area be updated to notify residents and visitors of the hours of enforcement; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the provisions of this Resolution be effective immediately, upon passage by the City Council.
