AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO **AWARD** RESOLUTION CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO W. BRADLEY ELECTRIC FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECTS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF INTERNATIONAL BOULEVARD AT 25TH AVENUE, BROADWAY AT BROADWAY TERRACE, AND BROADWAY AT COLLEGE AVENUE (CITY PROJECT NO. C159310 & C160210) IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY- THREE **DOLLARS AND NINETY-FIVE CENTS (\$362,753.95)**

WHEREAS, on January 5, 2004, the City Clerk received three bids for the CIP Traffic Signal Projects at the intersections of International Boulevard at 25th Avenue, Broadway at Broadway Terrace, and Broadway at College Avenue (CITY PROJECT NO. C159310 & C160210); and

WHEREAS, W. Bradley Electric submitted the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in each of the project budgets for the work and the project budget includes \$456,900 for construction of the work, inspection, administration and contingencies; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that services under this contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or her designee, is herby authorized to enter into a contract for the Traffic Signal Projects at the intersections of International Boulevard at 25th Avenue, Broadway at Broadway Terrace, and Broadway at College Avenue (CITY PROJECT NO. C159310 & C160210), with W. Bradley Electric in accordance with terms of its bid, dated January 5, 2004 for the amount of three hundred sixty-two thousand seven hundred fifty-three dollars and ninety-five cents (\$362,753.95); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of the Public Works Agency for Traffic Signal Projects at the intersections of International Boulevard at 25th Avenue, Broadway at Broadway Terrace, and Broadway at College Avenue (CITY PROJECT NO. C159310 & C160210) are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance, \$362,753.95 (100% of Contract), and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, \$362,753.95 (100% of Contract), with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute any amendments, or modifications of said contract without further City Council approval, except for increases in the contract amount; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreement shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy of the agreement shall be kept on file with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That, the City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously forthwith notice of the above award on the official bulletin board in the Office of the City Clerk.
