

2007 **RESOLUTION** No. 80730 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO RAY'S ELECTRIC FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AT TWO (2) INTERSECTIONS: 1) MOUNTAIN BOULEVARD AT STATE ROUTE 13 NORTHBOUND RAMPS, AND 2) SAN PABLO AVENUE (STATE ROUTE 123) AT 65TH STREET (CITY PROJECT NOS. C229110, C232710, C270210) IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND AND FORTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$376,049.00)

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2007, three (3) bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland, for the Citywide Traffic Signal Project (City Project Nos. C229110, C232710, C270210); and

WHEREAS, Ray's Electric submitted the lowest responsible and responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds for the construction contract in the State Gas Tax Fund (2211 and 2212); Capital Improvement Projects, Transportation Services Division, Organization (92246); and

WHEREAS, Ray's Electric complies with all Local/Small Local Business Enterprise Program requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy or better performance and that the services provided under the contract are of a technical and temporary natures and shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the construction contract for the Traffic Signal Project (City Project Nos. C229110, C232710, C270210) is hereby awarded to Ray's Electric in accordance with terms of its bid, dated May 14, 2007, in the amount of three hundred seventy-six thousand and forty-nine dollars (\$376,049.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of the Public Works Agency for the Traffic Signal Project (City Project Nos. C229110, C232710, C270210) are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance, \$376,049.00 (100% of contract), and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, \$376,049.00 (100% of contract), with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ray's Electric Company on behalf of the City of Oakland and execute any amendments or modifications of said contract within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all other bids are hereby rejected; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy of the contract shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously forthwith notice of the above award on the official bulletin board in the Office of the City Clerk.


