

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF HAMILTON V. CITY OF OAKLAND, ET AL., ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT, CASE NO. RG12610883, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 28254-A, IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT – MOTOR VEHICLE INJURY)

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Anika Hamilton alleges she was injured when an Oakland Police Department patrol car struck her in a pedestrian crosswalk at 7th Street at Clay Street on March 24, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Anika Hamilton filed the above referenced action to recover monetary damages for her injuries; and

WHEREAS, The City has determined to compromise and settle Plaintiff Anika Hamilton's claim against it for the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Anika Hamilton v. City of Oakland, et al., Alameda County Superior Court No. RG12610883, City Attorney's File No. 28254-A for a sum not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) payable by the City of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) be paid to Anika Hamilton, In Propria Persona.


