**RESOLUTION No. 83507 - C.M.S.**

**ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROVE AN INITIAL SALARY FOR THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT CITY ADMINISTRATOR THAT EXCEEDS THE MID-POINT AND NOT TO EXCEED THE TOP OF THE SALARY RANGE OF \$216,667 ANNUALLY, AS REQUIRED BY ORDINANCE NO. 12918 C.M.S.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Administrator is seeking the most qualified and experienced person to fulfill the role of Assistant City Administrator; and

**WHEREAS**, the midpoint of the salary range for the position as listed in Ordinance No. 12187 C.M.S. (the "Salary Ordinance") is \$180,555; and

**WHEREAS**, the midpoint of the salary is below the average salary range for similar positions in California cities with a population of 300,000 or more; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administrator requires sufficient flexibility in determining the salary level to attract the best candidate to the position; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to approve an initial salary for the position of Assistant City Administrator that exceeds the mid-point and up to the top of the salary range, which is \$216,667..


