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A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE FORMAL ADVERTISING AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BRICKER-MINCOLLA UNIFORMS FOR PROVISION OF FIREFIGHTER TROUSERS AND COATS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$130,000) FOR THE PERIOD MARCH 1, 2004 THROUGH MARCH 1, 2007 AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND SAID CONTRACT FOR TWO ADDITIONAL YEARS, ONE YEAR AT A TIME, UNTIL MARCH 1, 2009, FOR AN ADDITIONAL ANNUAL EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED FORTY THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTY THREE DOLLARS (\$43,333)

WHEREAS, firefighter protective clothing is mandated by CAL-OSHA to ensure a basic level of safety and protection for firefighting personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department determined through staff research and usage that the Flying Cross brand of firefighting trousers and coats provide a greater level of protection and safety than most other brands and offers specific patented items and qualities that are not present in other brands; and

WHEREAS, Bricker-Mincolla Uniforms is the only Northern California distributor of the Flying Cross clothing brand and has proprietary rights to the Fechheimer product; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council finds and determines, in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04.050, Section I, subparagraph 5, that it is in the best interests of the City to waive the formal bidding requirements and award the contract to Bricker Mincolla Uniform; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Manager is authorized execute a contract with Bricker Mincolla Uniforms for firefighter trousers and coats for OFD personnel, for the period March 1, 2004 through March 1, 2007, in an amount not to exceed a total expenditure of one hundred and thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000) for said term; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Manager may elect to extend all or parts of this contract one year at a time after March 1, 2007, with terms and conditions remaining the same, in an annual amount not to exceed a total annual expenditure of forty three thousand three hundred and thirty three dollars (\$43,333) per year for a total period of two years thereafter.



**FURTHER RESOLVED**: the contracts shall be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and a copy placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
