**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH, AND RECEIVE THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000) FROM, WITH THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL FOR INCREASED TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS TARGETED AT PREVENTING RECKLESS DRIVING AND EXHIBITIONS OF SPEED COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS SIDESHOWS**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department requests authorization to enter into a contract for services with, and receive \$30,000 from, the California Highway Patrol (CHP) to facilitate the Department's increased efforts to curb reckless driving and exhibitions of speed commonly referred to as Sideshows; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed traffic enforcement project is part of a larger traffic enforcement initiative sponsored by the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, administered through the CHP; and

**WHEREAS**, the five planned traffic enforcement operations associated with this initiative will take place during the period January 1, 2005 through September 30, 2005; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator, or her designee, to enter into a contract for services with, and receive \$30,000 from, the California Highway Patrol to provide increased traffic enforcement operations, and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That revenues and appropriations shall be maintained in the State of California Miscellaneous Grant Fund: 2999, Traffic Division Org.: 105647; Traffic Enforcement Program: PS14, in a Project to be determined; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations and related actions which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned contract for services; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney shall review and approve said contract with the California Highway Patrol as to form and legality.
