# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE UP TO THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS $\mathbf{( \$ 3 0 , 0 0 0 )}$ FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY, BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND FIREARMS (ATE), FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S GANG RESISTANCE EDUCATION AND TRAINING (G.R.E.A.T.) PROGRAM 

WHEREAS, the Department of the Treasury, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) has advised that the City of Oakland has been awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed thirty thousand dollars $(\$ 30,000)$ to support the Oakland Police Department's Gang Resistance Education and Training (G.R.E.A.T.) program; and

WHEREAS, funds provided for the G.R.E.A.T. initiative are earmarked to provide gang resistance education for students at Cole and Calvin Simmons Middle School, as well as one additional middle school location to be determined; and

WHEREAS, funding for the G.R.E.A.T. program will assist in the Police Department's goal of decreasing incidents of youth-based violence, and other delinquent activities; and

WHEREAS, these funds will support the Police Department's efforts to reduce youth violence within the City of Oakland; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or his designee to accept and appropriate up to thirty thousand dollars ( $\$ 30,000$ ) from the Department of the Treasury, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF), to the Police Department, and to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said grant shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund: 2112; Org.: 102460; in a Project Account to be determined.
