President Kernighan and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the City Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled action. Due to the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances settlement is recommended in the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$75,000.00) payable to Plaintiff Cecilio Felix and his attorney Christopher B. Dolan.

This action arises from an incident on June 25, 2010, wherein Mr. Felix was injured while crossing in the crosswalk and was struck by a vehicle at the intersection of 18th and Brush Streets in Oakland as that vehicle was attempting to make a left turn from 18th Street onto Brush Street. Mr. Felix sustained serious injuries in that accident requiring hospitalization.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 (moved by Councilmember Noel Gallo and seconded by Councilmember Gibson McElhaney - 5 Ayes, 1 Absent – Larry Reid, 1 Noe – Libby Schaff, 1 Abstention – Desley Brooks).
