WHEREAS, the Laney Tennis Court Resurfacing Project will benefit Oakland youth as well as existing tennis teams that use the Laney College tennis courts; and

WHEREAS, The City will require Laney Community College to provide documentation for use of the Councilmember's Pay-Go funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the grant of \$15,000.00 from Councilmember Henry Chang, Jr.'s Pay-Go funds to Laney Community College for the Laney Tennis Court Resurfacing Project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to execute an appropriate grant agreement with Laney Community College for the purposes of the grant, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
