Ordinance Creating the Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission and Specifying the Terms and Responsibilities of its Commissioners

An Ordinance has been prepared that will create a Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission in compliance with Metropolitan Transportation Commission Resolution 4108 regarding the required review of bicyclist and pedestrian projects funded by Transportation Development Act Article 3

The purpose of the Bicyclist and Pedestrian Advisory Commission is to advise City Council and staff on bicyclist- and pedestrian-specific plans, policies, projects, and programs, and on the accommodation of bicyclists and pedestrians in all transportation plans, policies, projects and programs. The Commission will serve as a resource to City staff and a forum for the public's participation in the review of the City's efforts to improve the safety of and access to walking and bicycling in Oakland.
