RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF PEARL YOUNGER v. CITY OF OAKLAND, ET AL., ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. RG10541304, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 27464, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00). (PW-TRIP AND FALL)

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2009, Plaintiff Pearl Younger tripped and fell on a sidewalk and suffered personal injuries and has filed a lawsuit alleging that a dangerous condition of public property caused the accident, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has determined that settlement in this amount, without an admission of liability, is in the best interest of the City; and now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Attorney is authorized and directed to settle the matter of Pearl Younger v. City of Oakland, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG10541304, City Attorney File No. 27464, for the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000), payable to Pearl Younger and her attorney, Terry Buller, Esq.; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000), payable to Pearl Younger and her attorney, Terry Buller, Esq.
