RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$1,000.00 FROM COUNCILMEMBER JEAN QUAN'S PAY-GO FUNDS TO THE WOODMINSTER MERCHANTS ASSOCIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF A WOODMINSTER DISTRICT SIGN.
