RESOLUTION NO. 76240 C.M.S.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE \$15,000 IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE TO THE COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY BUILDING SERVICES DIVISION

WHEREAS, the City staff has identified approximately twenty-five (25) pushcart food vendors operating illegally in the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the pushcart food vendors provide a service *to* the Oakland community with convenient locations, and,

WHEREAS, City staff has received complaints about nuisances related to the pushcart food vending use; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Pushcart Food Vending Pilot Program would result in increased costs to the City for administration, enforcement and monitoring of the program, estimated at a cost of \$500 per vendor; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that thirty (30) pushcart food vendors would apply for permits under the Pushcart Food Vending Pilot Program; and


WHEREAS, fees would generate approximately \$15,000 in revenues; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the public safety, health, convenience, comfort, property, and general welfare will be furthered by enforcement of the Pushcart Food Vending Pilot Program; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED; That the City Manager is hereby authorized to appropriate \$15,000 in revenue and expenditure to the Community and Economic Development Agency Building Services Division.


