RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF EVA M. AGUILLARD TO THE COMMISSION ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 9968 C.M.S., adopted August 5, 1980, and amended by Ordinance No. 11864 C.M.S, adopted March 12, 1996 created by Commission on Persons with Disabilities to address issues germane to accessibility, services and civil rights for persons with disabilities; and;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Persons with Disabilities consists of fifteen (15) members serving three years staggered terms with no more than two consecutive terms, and 51% of Commission members must be disabled persons; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Jean Quan has appointed Eva M. Aguillard to serve a three year term subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Eva M. Aguillard to the Commission of Persons with Disabilities for a three-year term beginning September 3, 2009 and ending September 2, 2012, filling the seat previously held by Petrina Alexander.
