INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER DESLEY BROOKS

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNCIL MEMBER DESLEY BROOKS TO TRAVEL TO LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA TO ATTEND THE POLICYLINK EQUITY SUMMIT OCTOBER 27-29, 2015

WHEREAS, Council Member Desley Brooks wishes to represent the City of Oakland at the PolicyLink Equity Summit in Los Angeles from October 27-29, 2015; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Council resolution No. 82800 C.M.S. approved by Council on June 1, 2010, which establishes a policy that Councilmembers, when seeking Council approval for travel, shall indicate whether City funds will be used when travel involves airline transportation and lodging, and shall provide an estimate of the cost of airline, lodging, per diem and conference fees when City funds are used and the source of City funding that will be used to cover the travel costs; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with City Council Resolution No. 82800 C.M.S., the estimated cost of transportation (including airfare and taxis/ ground transportation) is \$276.00, of lodging is \$398.00 for two nights, of per diem is \$168.00 for 3 days, of conference registration fees is \$450.00; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with City Council Resolution No. 82800 C.M.S., the source of City funding that will be used to cover the travel costs will be from City Council Contingency Project funds; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Desley Brooks seeks Council approval of the aforementioned estimated costs to travel to Los Angeles to attend the PolicyLink Equity Summit October 27-29, 2015; and

RESOLVED: That all expenses incurred for said travel are hereby authorized.

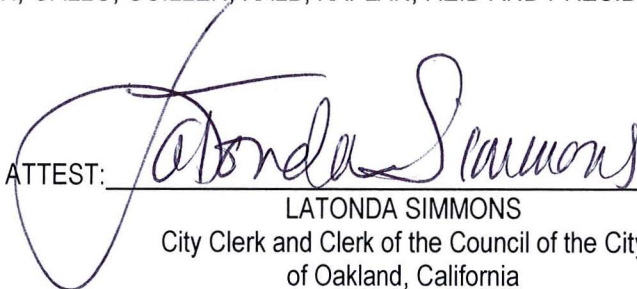
