RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF TWO SURPLUS MOTERCYCLES TO THE OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that two (2) motorcycles, vehicle numbers 2210 and 2227, which are 1996 Harley Davidson FLHPI police motorcycles, are surplus property owned by the City, which have a value exceeding their continued care, handling maintenance or storage: and

WHEREAS, said motorcycles are surplus to the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Oakland to enhance vehicular and pedestrian safety within the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of Oakland to increase the number of traffic enforcement officers deployed within the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department desires to donate two (2) of the City's surplus motorcycles to the Police & Safety Department of the Oakland Unified School District to enhance vehicular and pedestrian safety and to increase the number of traffic enforcement officers deployed within the City of Oakland: and

WHEREAS, the City Council may, pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code, Article 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.120, C, authorize the donation of surplus property, the value of which exceeds the cost of continued care, handling, maintenance or storage, to public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department has staff available to fully train, at no cost, two Oakland Unified School District Police Department Officers as motorcycle officers; and

WHEREAS, in addition to certain other releases, the Oakland Unified School District has agreed to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its Councilmembers, officers and agents from liability for actions, clams, losses, etc. that arise from the use of the donated motorcycles; now, therefore. be it

RESOLVED: That, pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code, Article **2**, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.120, C, the City Council finds and determines that vehicle numbers 2210 and 2227, 1996 Harley Davidson FLHPI motorcycles owned by Oakland, are surplus to the needs of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby finds and determines that, in the interests of traffic and pedestrian safety, it is in the best interests of the City to donate surplus motorcycles to the Oakland Unified School District, and authorizes the City Manager to take this action.
